Notice To Exhibitors

- 1 **Telegraph, telephone, unsigned, or incomplete entries cannot be accepted.** Entries without fees are not acceptable. Entry MUST be made on an official AKC entry form with the **AGREEMENT** printed on the reverse side, or a photocopy of same. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- 2 **CHANGES**, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Telephone changes are unacceptable. Changes may be faxed or emailed.
- 3 **A Recording Fee** of \$50 per dog and an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered in any Licensed or Member Club show, obedience trial, or tracking test. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. Each Rally entry fee includes \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on first entry and \$3.00 on each additional rally entry. The entry fee for Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy includes a \$2.00 AKC Recording Fee.
- 4 **PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink; DO NOT use pencil or colored ink to write entries.
- 5 **OWNERS OR THEIR AGENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS** on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors.
- 6 **ANY CHECK RETURNED FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS** will be charged a \$25.00 fee plus bank fees and must be paid in cash before the entry can be accepted. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in being put on a cash-only basis.
- 7 **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 8 **CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, the Show Secretary should be contacted.
- 9 **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6)
- 10 **DECLINATION OF ENTRIES:** The Club may decline any entry for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
- 11 **DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.
- 12 **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- 13 **THE SHOW GIVING CLUBS, THE SHOW SECRETARY,** their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians. The welfare of the exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
- 14 **NO PROVISIONS ARE MADE FOR UNENTERED DOGS AT THESE EVENTS.** All dogs must be kept on leash except when being judged in the obedience or rally ring, or in an exercise pen.
- 15 **ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE** in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Show Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The show-giving club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.
- 16 **ALL TROPHIES MUST BE CLAIMED ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW** -- none will be mailed.
- 17 The Clubs will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the show-giving clubs will not be responsible for loss or injury.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

<u>Veteran Dogs/Bitches</u>	<u>Hunting Dogs/Bitches</u>	<u>Field Trial Dogs/Bitches</u>
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Veteran Class for dogs/bitches 7 years & over. Spayed bitches and neutered dogs are allowed in Veterans classes at independent specialty shows.

Hunting Class for dogs/bitches which have earned a Junior, Senior or Master Hunter Title in an AKC Licensed or Member Test or a JAM or better in a Licensed Field Trial.

Field Trial Class for dogs/bitches that have received a Judge's Award of Merit or better at an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial.

Winners of these non-regular classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition, if undefeated in all classes.

BEST OF BREED

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. Winners of the Non-Regular Classes (Veteran, Hunting and Field Trial) may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show. No defeated dogs will be allowed to compete in Best of Breed.

OWNER-HANDLED BEST OF BREED

This event qualifies for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series. Exhibitor MUST check the Owner-Handled checkbox on the AKC Entry Form to be eligible. See information on Page 9.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

<u>Stud Dogs</u>	<u>Brood Bitches</u>
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Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dog and at least two (2) and no more than six (6) of his get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the get. Get MUST be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed or other Non-Regular Class at this show. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, Stud Dogs must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for the Breed.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and produce for get.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

SPECIAL AWARDS

AWARD OF MERIT: At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be given after Best of Breed is chosen. One (1) Award of Merit for every 5 (or portion thereof) entries in Best of Breed Competition.

BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES: To be selected from the Puppy Class winners (6-9, 9-12 mos) following the judging of Best of Breed Competition. If Best of Winners or Best of Breed is from a Puppy Class, it is automatically awarded Best in Puppy Classes.

Puppy & Veteran Sweepstakes

OFFERED BOTH DAYS

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES RULES

ELIGIBILITY: The Sweepstakes are open to all Irish Setters eligible for competition in the Regular AKC Conformation classes whose age will be no less than 6 months and no greater than **21 months** on the date of judging.

FEE: \$20.00 in addition to the regular entry fee. All entries in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular class in this show at the appropriate entry fee. Entries should be made at the same time on the same entry form as the Regular classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" with appropriate age and sex in the space provided for "Additional Classes." **CLEARLY INDICATE WHICH SWEEPS CLASS IS BEING ENTERED.** Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular classes. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES DIVISION OF STAKE

The stake shall consist of the total of all Sweepstakes entry fees. 35% of the entry fees will be retained to defray expenses. The remaining 65% shall be divided as follows:

- First Place in each class - 40%
- Second Place in each class - 30%
- Third Place in each class - 20%
- Fourth Place in each class - 10%

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES RULES

ELIGIBILITY: Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Setters who are at least 7 years old on the day of the show. **FEE:** \$20.00. Entrants need not be entered in any other class. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" on the official entry form, please include age. Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Conformation Classes.

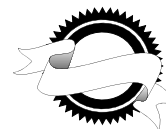

- 50% to Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes.



Parade of Title Holders

SATURDAY ONLY

Any dog who has earned a title American or Foreign, will be eligible to be entered and shown in the Exhibition Honor Parade. **ENTRY FEE** \$10.00, entry form to be marked "Parade" in the space provided for Additional Classes. The parade will be held during the lunch break. An imprinted Rosette will be awarded to each participant.

Junior Showmanship Classification

OFFERED BOTH DAYS

AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBERS are required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club at phone (919) 233-9767, or online at juniors@akc.org. For additional information contact the American Kennel Club at 5580 Centerview Drive, Raleigh, NC 27606. When entering this show, be sure to include all information required on both the front and back of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Novice Class - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

Open Class - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member club show.

Master Class - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten (10) First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry without charge, the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER - Selected from the winners of each Junior Showmanship class. Competition not required.

SUBSTITUTIONS - A dog may be substituted in Junior Showmanship. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made ½ hour prior to the judging of the Junior Showmanship classes at the show. All eligibility criteria above must be met. A Junior Handler is limited to one substitution per show.

Obedience Trial Classes

OFFERED SATURDAY ONLY for Irish Setters only. Move-ups are allowed. Judging to be held Outdoors. Dogs will sorted by jump height and run in decreasing order.

Veterans (for dogs 7 years & older)

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the entry fee for Obedience and/or Rally will be refunded. A processing fee of \$8.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season may be required as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.

Rally Trial Classes

OFFERED SATURDAY ONLY, for Irish Setters only. Move-ups are allowed. Judging to be held Outdoors. Rally ring size to be approximately 40 x 60 feet. Rally entrants must specify their jump height for the Advanced, Excellent and Masters classes. Bitches in Season may not compete in Rally classes. See above for refund policy.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

OFFERED BOTH DAYS

Determining Eligibility:

- Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the **CHECK BOX on the entry form.**
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book and in the show catalog.
- Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.
- Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. *This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.*

Determining Owner-Handled Best of Breed

- Breed judging for OH Best of Breed is conducted following Best of Breed judging in the ring. All dogs in BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members, and current assistants to a professional handler, and any exhibitor that did not indicate on their entry that they were eligible for NOHS to leave the ring. The judge will then select the Owner-Handled Best of Breed. A dog being "cut" or otherwise "defeated" in the BOB ring remains eligible to compete for Owner-Handled Best of Breed.

Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition

OFFERED BOTH DAYS

This competition is open to Irish Setter puppies at least 4 months and under 6 months on the day of the Specialty. The competition is not divided by sex. The competition will be held before the lunch break each day. The judge will select Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex from all puppies entered in the competition. The following requirements must be met:

- The puppy is required to have an AKC registration number or an AKC litter number. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- Use the Official AKC Entry Form and specify "Four-to-Six Month Puppy" in the space for Dog Show Class. Entry deadline is the same closing date as the specialties (March 17, 2021).

Purpose. The Irish Setter Club of the Pacific (S.F.), is committed to the safety and well-being of their members, volunteers, visitors, competitors, event officials, and dogs. We will comply with all Federal, State, County, and City laws, regulations, directives, and ordinances while incorporating best practices published to the public by various Federal, State, County, and City authorities into our policies and procedures. Our Coronavirus (COVID-19) policies and procedures are subject to change with the introduction of additional governmental guidelines and will be updated, as necessary.

Scope. These policy and procedures apply to all individuals who physically participate in ISCP events, trainings, meetings, and competitions, regardless of location. To the extent that any Federal, State, County, or city authority issues a best practice, notice, or order that conflicts with this document, the Federal, State, County, or City directive shall apply due to the frequency that the same may be issued.

COVID-19 Safety Policies and Procedures

Prior to Event. All persons coming onto the grounds for these events must file: (1) Waiver and (2) COVID-19 Self-Declaration Statement included at the end of premium list. This includes all exhibitors, owners, handlers, officials including judges and stewards, family members, and children. A parent/guardian must sign for children under 18 years of age. Copies will be available at Check-In Desk for those who have not filed forms, or for anyone else at the events. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN PEN.**

General Procedures At Event:

- Social distancing of at least 6-feet should be maintained between non-household members AT ALL TIMES, whether wearing a mask or not.
- **FACE MASKS ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN BY ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THESE EVENTS** (exhibitors, handlers, judges, officials, committee, everyone) in any of the following conditions: (1) Indoors, including restrooms and portapotties; (2) Outdoors within any ring or within 10' of any occupied ring; or (3) Outdoors within 6' of any person not in your same household. Bring your own mask. See additional mask specifications in ISCP Face Mask Policies later in premium list.
- All vulnerable individuals should shelter at home and NOT attend in-person events, trainings, meetings, and competitions. Members of households with vulnerable residents should be mindful of inadvertent exposure to COVID-19 and the possibility of exposure to those most vulnerable.
- **RV PARKING:** When possible 30 foot spacing between individual parties of all campers, RV's, horse trailers, and tents with 6 feet of social distancing from non- household members at camp sites shall be maintained.
- Entering and leaving facilities and events: Do not cluster at doorways, gates or openings. Hand Sanitizer will be available and is recommended for use frequently. Wash hands as frequently as possible.
- **EVENT SECRETARY TENT:** Authorized personnel only. Maximum of two persons (Show Secretary and one other person) at any time in the tent. Anyone in the Secretary Tent must follow 6-foot social distancing requirements and wear a face mask.
- There will be no food available for purchase on the grounds. Potlucks are not allowed. Food may be shared only with members of your same household.

- Avoid shaking hands, hugging or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use of pens/pencils - bring your own.
- Specialty Catalogs will be available by pre-purchase only. Please avoid cash transactions on the grounds.

Event Check-In:

- Upon entering the grounds (each day), all persons must come to Designated Check-In Desk and have temperature taken. If temperature is higher than 98.6 F, then the person must leave grounds and seek medical advice. No refunds will be issued.
- If temperature is normal and under 98.6 F, and the Waiver and COVID-19 Self-Declaration forms are filed, then person will be issued a wristband and allowed onto the grounds. The wristband must be worn at all times on the grounds and be visible. New wristbands will be issued each day of shows.
- If anything changes in your condition over the weekend, please leave the site and seek medical care. Do not endanger anyone else. Please notify Janet Jenkins Hylton at (925) 437-4530 or email ashtonirishsetters@gmail.com, or Jeanette Holmes (530) 518-7472, or email Estrellairish@sbcglobal.net, or the designated Show Chairperson that day.
- After satisfying the entrance requirements and wristband is issued, exhibitors will proceed to Armband Table with envelopes, sorted by owner's last name. Do not congregate in the area. All must be masked and socially distanced by at least 6 feet. Envelope will contain armbands for all dogs entered by the owner that day and updated procedures. The armbands for dogs with Entry Forms listing a HANDLER/AGENT will be separated out for the agent. If there are multiple shows same day, all armbands for the day will be included. If a Specialty Show Catalog was pre-ordered, it will be with the armband envelope. NOTE THAT CATALOGS WILL BE AVAILABLE BY PRE-PURCHASE ONLY.
- After retrieving your envelope, please verify that your armbands are correct. They will be labelled on the underside with name of dog, owner, class and armband#. Contact Event Secretary Debi Best at the Secretary Tent, or phone (510) 915-0597 or email DLBest7@earthlink.net if there is a problem with your entry. Please do move-ups the previous day by email if possible.

Conformation Ring Procedures:

- Exhibitors will proceed to the judging ring area and check their entries into their classes. There will be large posted signs with class lists. Check your dogs into your classes (using your own pen)- this is so the ring steward knows your dog is present. Do not congregate in area. Stay socially distanced. Do not touch the Ring Steward's catalog.
- No spectators will be allowed at ringside, you must watch from your setup. The only handlers/dogs near the ring should be those in the ring currently being judged, and the following class which will assemble in a nearby Ready Ring. Stay in catalog order, socially distanced at least 6' apart. The ring steward will check that each entrant is ready.
- Ring will have two gates - entrance and exit. When a class is completed, the judge will make his/her placements. Class ribbons and prizes will be available for self-pickup leaving the ring via the "exit gate." Stay socially distanced at all times.
- Additional or updated procedures and guidelines will be published with the judging schedule and posted on the grounds during the shows.

Obedience/Rally COVID-19 Safety Procedures:

- The Obedience Figure 8 exercise will use upright posts, tall pylons or chairs as posts. The posts may be left in the ring during other exercises.
- Judges may wear gloves or use hand sanitizer between examination exercises. If a judge chooses to use gloves, a new pair of gloves will be used for each dog.
- Examinations – Social distancing requirements will be met during examination exercises. For the Utility Moving Stand for Examination, the judge should approach the dog at a slight angle to ensure distancing requirements from handler to judge are maintained.
- Additional or updated procedures and guidelines will be published with judging schedule.

ISCP Face Mask Policy

Face masks are necessary to protect yourself and others to prevent the spread of infectious diseases including the COVID-19 virus, according to government sources.

All attendees (ages 2 and up) are required to wear a face mask while on the event grounds. The face mask must be worn so that it covers your mouth and nose. Please bring your own face masks and wear them at all times. The use of a face mask is not a substitute for physical distancing. You may remove the face mask while actively eating or drinking, but you must be stationary and maintain appropriate physical distancing. No eating or drinking will be permitted inside.

All face masks (whether disposable or reusable) must:

- Be made with at least two or more layers of washable (if not disposable), breathable fabric and not have valves or vents
- If using a disposable mask it should be changed daily and disposed of properly
- Fully cover the nose and mouth
- Fit snugly against the sides of your face and not have gaps.
- Be secured with ties or ear loops and allow the attendee to remain hands-free
- If you are using a face shield you must also wear a face mask.

The following are not permitted:

- Neck Gaiters
- Open chin triangle bandanas
- Face masks with valves, vents, mesh material or holes of any kind.

To get the most benefits from a face mask:

- Make sure it completely covers your nose and mouth.
- Wash your hands before and after removing it. Handle only the loops or ties. Fold outside corners together.
- Try not to touch your face when you adjust it throughout the day.
- Keep cloth coverings clean by washing daily, or more often if contamination occurs.
- Don't let others wear your face mask.
- Keep it away from equipment or machinery that it could get caught in.
- If using disposable face masks, do not reuse them, and throw them away in appropriate trash receptacles.
- Don't lay your face mask on any surface that may contaminate either the covering or the surface.
- Don't use it if it's damaged or has holes, unless it is the only face mask you have access to.

As important as they are, face masks are only one source of prevention. All attendees will be required to comply with all COVID-19 Safety Protocols and Policies. These protocols and policies are subject to change without notice.

Failure to comply with this policy may result in you being asked to leave the event grounds and/or may result in an Event Committee hearing and disciplinary action.
